CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

Pol Roger Cuvee Winston Churchill, France, 1996 - £150

The mousse is generous and the fruit is both pure and powerful, backed up by a subtle minerality and gentle hints of ginger and spice.

Pol Roger Brut Vintage, France, 2000 - £60

Intense gold with persistent fine mousse. The nose opens with floral rose notes and warms to toasted brioche. Full and fresh flavours with spicy floral notes underpinned with candied yellow fruit.

Pol Roger Brut, France, NV - £42

Bright apple and citrus, plenty of rich toasted oak and nuttiness, and a lingering finish combine to make this a versatile but impressive champagne.

Lanson Black Label, France, NV - £37

A touch of “toast” and honey. Bouquets of ripe citrus fruit.

Orsola Prosecco, Italy, NV - £20

Bright, breezy, fresh and foaming, a delicious sparkling wine with delightful pear fruit and mild acidity.

Freixenet Cordon Negro Brut, Spain, NV - £18

A crisp, clean and well balanced Cava with acidity that is lower than most.

Freixenet Cordon Negro Rosado, Spain, NV - £18

Satin-like ripe cherry and berry flavours. This Cava is surprisingly dry with a long bubbly finish.

ROSE

Barefoot White Zinfandel, California, NV - £14

This pink pearl is packed with seriously lush pineapple & strawberry and it tastes deliciously fruity.

Tall Horse Pinotage Rose, South Africa, 2010 - £16

This rose is a fruit-filled “quaffer” with plenty of complexity to stand up to food. Easy drinking, with gentle perceived sweetness.



Palmento Nero D'Avola, Italy, 2008 - £15

The most important red wine grape in Sicily & easily comparable to a light Shiraz. This one is full of spicy plum notes.

**Louise Jadot Beaujolais Villages, Combe aux Jaques,
France, 2009 - £18**

Bursting with ripe, juicy raspberry and cherry fruit flavours.
Light bodied, beautifully balanced and truly scrumptious.

El Descanso Estate Merlot Reserva, Chile, 2010 - £15

Softly textured & exceptionally smooth. Soft palate with classical
herbal blackberry and coffee flavours with deep colour.

Esk Valley Pinot Noir, New Zealand, 2008 - £20

Plums and black cherries dominate with a light oak seasoning.
The wine has the soft mouth feel, but a tannic backbone provides
structure and age worthiness.

Faustino VII Rioja, Spain, 2008 - £16

Smooth & fruity with ripe raspberry & a hint of tobacco smoke.
Lighter than its bigger brother, "I Gran Reserva"
without missing a beat in flavour.

Douglas Green Pinotage, South Africa, 2009 - £14

A medium bodied fruit driven red wine; a soft juicy structure for
youthful drinking! With lush red berry & spice flavours and aromas.

**Peter Lehmann Clancy's Shiraz Cabernet Merlot,
Australia, 2008 - £16**

This wine is the stuff of legends with a rich, balanced palate
and smooth finish. It follows the pioneering Australian
tradition of blending Shiraz & Cabernet Sauvignon,
with a touch of Merlot to soften.



SMOOTH REDS



Errazuriz Wild Ferment Pinot Noir, Chile, 2009 - £25

Renowned for its full body, rich fruit & silky texture, but also its wild, sexy earthiness. Well-balanced acidity with a long finish.

Best served lightly chilled.

Côtes Du Rhône Le Pas de La Beaume, France, 2009 - £20

Packed full of Southern French “Garrigue” character of herbs and spices, lots of fruit and with a lovely structure.

Chateau Dupray St Emilion, France, 2007 - £30

This Saint-Emilion has aromas of fruit of the forest. The wine is well structured and fruity with pleasant tannins.

Mount Langi Billi Billi Shiraz, Australia, 2005 - £19

It has a nice line and length of beautiful, regional plummy flavour, along with some spiciness and a touch of eucalyptus in support.



**Robert Mondavi Woodbridge Zinfandel,
California, 2008 - £16**

The lower alcohol content opens up the fruit content of this delectable wine. It exhibits dark berry fruit and oak spice coupled with a soft lingering finish.

**Errazuriz Max Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon,
Chile, 2008 - £20**

Spicy redcurrant and cassis aromas with cedar, tobacco and musky herbs; really smells like a traditional Bordeaux. Firm and focused, with juicy red berry and bitter cherry flavours. A wine with impressive balance and precision.

Don Reca, Chile, 2008 - £30

The 2008 Cuvee Don Reca is a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere, and Syrah. It exhibits an aromatic array of eucalyptus, violets, clove, sage, and blackcurrants. Mouth-filling, intense, and spicy.

**Domaine La Souco Papale Chateauneuf-du-Pape,
France, 2007 - £35**

The Grenache core gives baked and jam fruits, finishing with spicy notes. Drinking well from 2009 so order while at its best!

Faustino I Gran Reserva, Spain, 1998 - £30

Fruity, smoky, spicy with a hint of tar and liquorice. A classic Rioja - lighter than expected with smooth tannins; the finish is fine chocolate and cherry.

Villa Lanata Barolo Riserva, Italy, 2003 - £45

Cherry, raspberry & raisin flavours with smoky spice & leather. Dry with high acidity & near perfect balance.

Antinori Peppoli Chianti Classico, Italy, 2008 - £22

The "first name" in Chianti delivers ripe raspberry & redcurrant flavours. A silky fruit driven wine with a lingering finish & soft, sweet tannins.



CRISP WHITES

Douglas Green Chenin Blanc, South Africa, 2009 - £14

Easy drinking, dry light & fruity wine that is crisp & enticing. A delicious social drinking wine which works just as well alone as it does with food.

Petit Chablis Pas Si Petit, France, 2009 - £25

This “not so petit” wine is brilliant! The nose is open, fine & lively. The finale is lengthened with a fruity freshness.

Lamberti Pinot Grigio Santepietre, Italy, 2009 - £16

One of our modern classics, this wine is one of life’s perfectionists. White, light, dry & unoaked.

Gavi di Gavi Toledana, Villa Lanata, Italy, 2009 - £22

Impeccably made in a light gooseberry & mineral style with delicate floral hints.

Chablis La Chablisienne Vieille Vignes, France, 2006 - £30

What more is there to say, except clean, light & flinty with just a hint of warmth. At its peak right now, so drink up!



MEDIUM & BALANCED

Vidal Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 2009 - £16

Capsicum and gooseberry aromas with a palate that bursts with tropical fruit flavours. A lively acidity and crisp finish balance perfectly.

Vasse Felix Semillon Sauvignon Blanc, Australia, 2010 - £25

A vibrant and refined Sauvignon Semillon Blanc resulting in a wine of great character with 'steely' acidity and length.

Guy Saget Sancerre, France, 2008 - £30

Ever longed for a wine that smells of summer? You've just found it! Refreshing, balanced acidity with a slight gooseberry tang.

Mount Langi Billi Billi Pinot Grigio, Australia, 2009 - £18

Packed with grapefruit and green apple flavours, and with underlying tropical characteristics. The zesty crispness keeps the finish dry and refreshing.

FULL & FLAVOURSOME

Villa Maria Private Bin Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 2010 - £19

Flavours of ripe gooseberries, passionfruit & exotic herbaceous aromas finishing with crisp, clean acidity. Totally delicious!

Villa Maria Cellar Selection Chardonnay, New Zealand, 2008 - £22

A tight, youthful bouquet of citrus lemon and stone fruit, with hints of lime, cashew and complex oatmeal notes. The wine shows its Marlborough origin with lovely refinement, balance and length.

Leasingham Bin 7 Riesling, Clare Valley, Australia, 2008 - £19

From one of Australia's finest wineries, this Riesling is bone dry and has mouth-watering acidity with a long finish.

Errazuriz Chardonnay, Chile, 2010 - £16

Aromas of ripe papaya, vanilla and pear precede apple pie and buttered toast flavours before a delicate, long, lemony finish.

Peter Lehmann Chardonnay, Australia, 2008 - £19

A beautifully balanced wine with delicious fruit characters and wonderful depth of flavour. This stunning wine shows great complexity and a refreshing dry finish.



PORT & DESSERT

Warre's Otima 10Yr Old Tawny Port (500ml),
Portugal, NV - £30

Dark amber, with a warm caramel nose. Smooth, accommodating
flavours of caramel and burnt orange with a medium finish.

Graham's Late Bottled Vintage, (750ml), Portugal, 2005 - £30

Excellent LBV with aromas of plum jam, forest fruit, prunes and figs.
Full of fruit on the palate with plums dominating, smooth & full-bodied
with a long finish.

Errazuriz Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, (375ml),
Chile, 2007 - £15

Concentrated ripe fruit aromas, including apricot
interlaced with subtle notes of orange zest and a hint of
honey balanced perfectly against well-integrated oak.
Crisp acidity maintains the wine's freshness.



CHAMPAGNE & SPARKING (200ML)

Lanson Black Label, France, NV - £10

A touch of "toast" and honey. Bouquets of ripe fruit and citrus fruit.

Freixenet Cordon Negro Brut, Spain, NV - £6

A crisp, clean and well balanced Cava with acidity that is lower than most.

ROSE (175ML)

Barefoot White Zinfandel, California, NV - £4.95

This pink pearl is packed with seriously lush pineapple & strawberry and it tastes deliciously fruity.

WHITE (175ML)

Villa Maria Private Bin Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 2010 - £4.95

Flavours of ripe gooseberries, passionfruit & exotic herbaceous aromas finishing with crisp, clean acidity. Totally delicious!

Errazuriz Chardonnay, Chile, 2010 - £4.95

Aromas of ripe papaya, vanilla and pear precede apple pie and buttered toast flavours before a delicate, long, lemony finish.

RED (175ML)

Faustino VII Rioja, Spain, 2008 - £4.95

Smooth & fruity with ripe raspberry & a hint of tobacco smoke. Lighter than its bigger brother, "I Gran Reserva" without missing a beat in flavour.

Mount Langi Billi Shiraz, Australia, 2005 - £4.95

It has a nice line and length of beautiful, regional plummy flavour, along with some spiciness and a touch of eucalyptus in support.

PORT & DESSERT

Warre's Otima 10Yr Old Tawny Port (500ml), Portugal, NV - £5.25

Dark amber, with a warm caramel nose. Smooth, accommodating flavours of caramel and burnt orange with a medium finish.

Errazuriz Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, (375ml), Chile, 2007 - £5.50

Concentrated ripe fruit aromas, including apricot interlaced with subtle notes of orange zest and a hint of honey balanced perfectly against well-integrated oak.
